Meet and Ride?

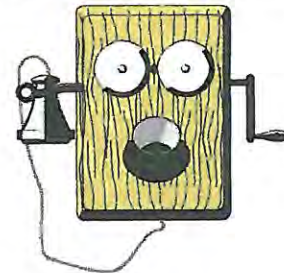
